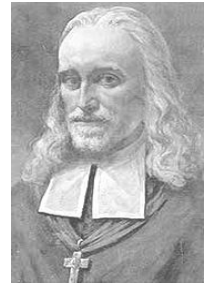

Baptism: 50 **Funerals:** 50 mourners in addition to clergy and funeral directors **Weddings:** 20 persons plus the couple, the celebrant and assisting ministers are permitted. **Reconciliation:** by appointment or 4 pm Saturday
