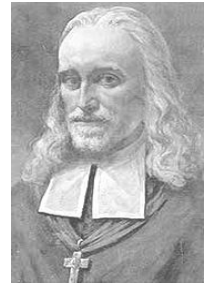

#### SACRAMENTS @ ST OLIVER'S

**Reconciliation, Baptism, Marriage and Funerals, RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

**COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) UPDATE: NEW WEDDING GUIDELINES**

From September 14, new Government regulations were introduced that affect all weddings, and Church properties. Up to 150 people are now allowed to attend a wedding service at a place of public worship. This number was previously limited to 100 people. Social distancing and the 4 square metre per person requirements are still in place.
