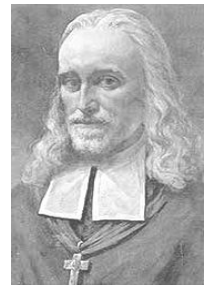

### 28 March 2021 - Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

#### SACRAMENTS @ ST OLIVER'S

**Reconciliation, Baptism, Marriage and Funerals, RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

Baptisms, Funerals and Weddings are allowed to take place under strict government guidelines with regards to social distancing (at least 2 square metres of space for each person is observed), hygiene (hand sanitising) and registering names and contact details.

#### Re: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Update

NSW Health has revised the COVID-19 guidelines for places of worship.

#### Effective from 27 March 2021

There will be no restrictions on choirs and congregational singing in places of worship. This is subject to one person per 2 square metres. This means singing will be allowed for Palm Sunday.

#### Effective from 29 March 2021

Limits at places of worship will only be subject to the 2 square metre rule. Religious venues will be allowed at least 25 people before the 2 square metre rule applies. There will be no caps on the number of people allowed to attend weddings and funerals. The 2 square metre rule will still apply at these events.

#### Outdoor Areas

Parishes might also consider using outdoor areas for Easter week, weather permitting. Outdoor spaces are subject to the 2 square metre rule.

#### Face masks

Wearing of face masks at places of worship continues to be strongly recommended, especially indoors and when social distancing is not possible.
