

THE 2021 NATIONAL COUNT OF MASS ATTENDANCE

As you are aware, the counting started last week, 1 May 2021. Held every five years since 2001, the project is a simple head count of all attenders at all parishes and other Mass centres, such as migrant community centres, hospitals, prisons, boarding schools etc and other types of Sunday Assemblies across Australia over the first four weekends of May. This count is organised by the National Centre for Pastoral Research on behalf of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference. The National Count is conducted in the same year as the Australian Census (to be held on 10 August 2021). It will be a simple headcount: no other information about individual attenders will be collected.

This year's National Count of Attendance will also seek to understand how people participate in Mass online from home. Parishes and dioceses that stream Sunday Masses are encouraged to share what information they have, including the number of 'views' for each Mass during May.

Statistics from this year's count are expected to be released in 2022, meaning they can be assessed alongside the Census population data.
